- Your OWN BIBLE in a translation you understand and can write in (not a phone)
 - *If you don't have one, let Anna know and we will hook you up
- A journal to write in
- Twin-sized air mattress, bedding and pillow
- Work clothes (for 2 days, Sunday Monday)

Work clothes are: 2 pairs of jeans, 2 pairs of shorts, t-shirts, 1-2 long sleeve shirts, and sturdy, close-toed shoes with tread

- 2 sets of comfortable leisure clothes (every day for after work) Include a sweatshirt.
- Underwear (this is plural, so like at least 3 pairs)
- Leather work gloves
- Safety glasses/eye protection
- Bath Towel, washcloth
- Personal toiletries (pack bottles of liquids in plastic bags)
- Soap/deodorant/ shampoo/toothbrush/ toothpaste/etc.
- Shower shoes
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Air mattress; twin-sized
- Hat
- Nalgene water bottle/Reusable water bottle (with your name on it)
- A favorite candy with no nuts to give to your prayer buddy
- A game you like to play with a group (if you have one)
- Rain jacket
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Chapstick/eye drops
- Flashlight
